



Travel and Accommodation for EuPAT 11

EuPAT 11 will take place at the Technology and Innovation Centre at the University of Strathclyde in Glasgow. The university campus sits in the heart of Glasgow's city centre, offering a wide range of options in terms of travel and accommodation.

Flying to Glasgow

There are two airports in Glasgow, Glasgow International Airport and Glasgow Prestwick Airport. There is also an airport in the nearby city of Edinburgh, which connects to Glasgow by a shuttle bus service.

Glasgow International Airport

The easiest way to get from Glasgow International Airport to the city centre is using the Glasgow Airport Express Service 500 shuttle bus. Travelling to and from the city centre on this service takes around 15 minutes, with the service operating regularly throughout the day. Tickets can be purchased on the [FirstBus mobile app](#), [online](#), or onboard the bus. For the Technology and Innovation Centre, the nearest stop on this route is at George Square.

Prestwick Airport

The easiest way to travel between Prestwick Airport and Glasgow city centre is by train. Trains run between Glasgow Central Station and Prestwick Airport, with a journey time of around 45 minutes each way. Tickets can be purchased via the [ScotRail website](#) or using an alternative service such as [Trainline](#).

Edinburgh Airport

For some locations, flying to Edinburgh Airport might offer more suitable routes, times, or prices. A shuttle bus runs between Edinburgh Airport and Glasgow city centre, taking approximately 1 hour. More information on travelling to Glasgow via Edinburgh airport can be found [here](#).

Travelling by Train

The main train stations which offer travel to and from the rest of the UK are Glasgow Central Station and Glasgow Queen Street. Glasgow Central station is approximately a 15 minute walk from the Technology and Innovation Centre. Glasgow Queen Street station is approximately 10 minutes walk from the Technology and Innovation Centre. Both train stations also have taxi ranks operating at the main Entrance/Exit. Train tickets can be purchased [online](#) as either mobile tickets or tickets can be collected using the ticket machines at each station.
